HANDOUTS TO FLOOR REPS

Before Talking to the floor members Pl. go through the Pamplet carefully and in case of doubt, consult the core team.

Things to stress/remember while talking to floor members: PI. take this printout with you while talking to the floor members.

- We are doing this as we have received two notices from BBMP and very soon it is going to be mandatory to segregate our waste. Hence to get in to the habit we are implementing it.
- If segregation is not done, there is a danger of our waste not being picked up and fines imposed.
- We are going to segregate DRY waste into TWO labeled Bags given to each household.
- The bags will also be marked with Flat No.
- The bags will be given free of cost for the first time. After that if replacement is needed the household has to pay for it. At present the bags cost Rs 5 per bag.
- Glass bottles and Tin Cans are to be stored in a separate bag because (a) there is a danger of breakage of glass and (b) these items fetch a higher price from ITC
- Large Empty Cartons like Fridge, TV boxes and those used for shifting are to be kept separately
 outside your doorstep and will be picked up by housekeeping.
- Please refer to the Pamphlet for finding items that fall under various categories. If there are items that are not listed in the pamphlet, households to check with floor reps on the categorization.
- Please keep in mind the Things to remember for segregation. Read out each point to them
- Sanitary waste put into the BBMP trash in a hygienic fashion is a must to deal with drainage problems also.
- News paper drive is not planned in future, however if the households wish they can give it towards dry waste in tied bundles only on weekly basis on the dry waste collection day.
- E waste to be done by the resident in to the bins placed near security. There will be 2 bins, one near front security and one at the back gate security.
- We will be there (Floor Reps) to help you understand if you have any doubts.
- This can become effective only if you co-operate. Hence this is our request to you.
