FORM OF UNDERTAKING FOR DYEING, PRINTING, DRY CLEANING LAUNDRY,
PAINT, LACQUER, TAR MANUFACTURE, STORES AND SALE AND THE LIKE

I/We wish to apply for the renewal of our trade licence. In this regard the following particulars furnished by me are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

1. That I/We am/ are carrying on trade of -----at the above premise.
2. That a trade license has been granted to us vide No.----- dated ----- issued by ----- Bangalore Mahanagara Palike on -----
3. That the above licence granted is due to expire on-----
4. That I/We are now applying for the renewal of the trade licence being carried out in the said premise under the automatic trade licence approval scheme.
5. That I have submitted the renewal application on ----- (date of submission) under the said scheme in the prescribed form and remitted the licence fee of Rs..... Rupees.....in favour of Commissioner Mahanagara Palike by demand draft drawn on ----- Branch-----Bank.
6. That I am aware of the conditions prescribed under the byelaws issued under the KMC Act 1976 from time to time commonly for installing and running Dyeing and printing on clothes and I abide to follow these prescribed conditions applicable to the trade carried on by me/us more fully described herein under:
 - a) That no person shall use any premises within 100 yards of any human habitation for

dyeing, printing, dry cleaning, laundry, paint and lacquer manufacturing and stocking , storing of tar and the like.

- b) That every person who uses any premises for the purpose of dyeing, printing, dry cleaning, laundry, paint and lacquer manufacturing and stocking , storing of tar and the like shall cause all materials which have been received upon such premises and which are not required for immediate use to be stored in such a manner and in such condition as to prevent the emission of noxious or injurious effluvia there from.
- c) That it is incumbent to maintain at all times good order and efficient action all such means and appliances as are necessary for rendering innocuous all gas, vapour, fumes dust or other impurities emitted during any trade process either from the articles operated upon or from the contents of any cask, tank, vessel, or utensil or other receptacle upon such premises.
- d) That sufficient supply of pure and wholesome water is provided and shall cause such premises to be thoroughly cleansed as often as may be necessary and at least once in every 24 hours and shall prevent any accumulation of filth or refuse therein.
- e) That every floor or pavement upon such premises shall be kept at all times in good order and repair so as to prevent the absorption of any liquid filth or refuse or any noxious or injurious matter which may fall or be deposited thereon.
- f) That the drying ground and all the ground surface of such premises shall be kept smooth and free from hollows or inequalities so as to prevent any accumulation thereon of any liquid filth or refuse.
- g) That suitable means of ventilation, lighting and means of drainage in such premises shall be provided and shall cause the same to be maintained at all times in good order. Secondly, the coloured refuse shall be disposed in such manner as may be approved by the BWSSB and shall in no case let coloured refuse into any public drain without the written permission of the BWSSB.
- h) That every part of the internal surface of the walls and ceiling of every building upon such premises shall lime-washed twice at least every year in the months of April and October and more often if so required by the Medical Officer of Health.
- i) That all refuse matter, which may have fallen or have been deposited upon any part of the said premises shall be collected and deposited in suitable airtight non-absorbent covered receptacles to the satisfaction of the Medical Officer of Health. That all such refuse shall be removed from such premises at least once in every 24 hours and disposed as per direction.
- j) That there is no stagnation of water or any unused dye pots or receptacles in such premises.
- k) That traders should run the Trade without causing nuisance to the neighbors within the time limit (6 AM to 6 PM)
- l) That certificate from pollution board for sound and dust regulation must be obtained.
- m) Besides these conditions imposed, I will also abide by all other regulations under all other Central and State laws connected in the upkeep of hygiene, safety and public health.

- n) That an inspection/complaints book shall always be available in the trade premises in which customers or Inspecting Officers may enter their remarks or note their complaints and such book shall be open to inspection by any Inspecting Officer of the Corporation.

In accordance with these prescribed conditions I/we hereby state that I/we have, to the best of our knowledge and belief, have fulfilled the required conditions for the trade carried on by me/us before applying for this renewal of trade licence. If, upon inspection by the Commissioner or his delegated authority, it is found that I/we have not adhered to these conditions imposed, I/we are aware that the licence issued under the Automatic Trade Licence Approval Scheme, will be revoked. Further I /we HEREBY UNDERTAKE to indemnify/and keep harmless the Corporation from all proceedings in Court and before any other authorities including the competent authority under appropriate Central and State law in force, all express/losses/claims which the Corporation may incur or become liable to pay as a result or in consequence of the renewal of this trade licence.
