FORM OF UNDERTAKING FOR MEAT, CHICKEN, FISH, PORK, BEEF AND THE LIKE FOR STORAGE AND SALE.

I/We wish to apply for the renewal of our trade licence. In this regard the following particulars furnished by me are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

1. That I/We am/ are carrying on trade of -----at the above premise.
2. That a trade license has been granted to me/us vide No.----- dated ----- issued by ----- Bangalore Mahanagara Palike on -----
3. That the above licence granted is due to expire on-----
4. That I/We are now applying for the renewal of the trade licence being carried out in the said premise under the automatic trade licence approval scheme.
5. That I/We have submitted the renewal application on ----- (date of submission) under the said scheme in the prescribed form and remitted the licence fee of Rs..... Rupees.....in favour of Commissioner Mahanagara Palike by demand draft drawn on ----- Branch-----Bank.
6. That I am aware of the conditions prescribed under the byelaws issued under the KMC Act 1976 from time to time commonly for those engaged in the storing packing pressing cleaning preparation and sale of mutton, chicken, fish, pork, and beef stalls:
 - a) That the establishments shall be located at a place which is at a distance of

at least 10 meters away from the site where public garbage bins, public toilets and public urinals.

- b) That every person will provide a sufficient and good supply of water in such premises and shall cause such premises to be thoroughly cleansed at least twice in every twenty-four hours or more often, if necessary, and shall prevent any accumulation of filth or refuse therein.
- c) That liquid refuse before it is discharged into a public drain will be cooled in such manner as to prevent the emission of noxious or injurious effluvia there from; and shall not let or cause to be let in to public drain any greasy or oily refuse matter.
- d) That all refuse, fragments of animal or other matter which have fallen or have been deposited upon any part of such premises shall be collected and deposited in suitable non-absorbent and impervious receptacle provided with tight-fitting covers to the satisfaction of the Medical Officer of Health. Secondly, all such refuse shall be removed from such premises at least once in every 24 hours and dispose of in such matter as may be approved by the Commissioner.
- e) That every part of the internal surface of the walls and ceiling of every building upon such premises shall lime-washed twice at least every year in the months of April and October and more often if so required by the Health Officers.
- f) That suitable means of drainage shall be provided upon or in connection with such premises and maintain it in good condition.
- g) That suitable means of lighting and ventilation shall be provided at the premises.
- h) That no persons shall be permitted to take their meals in such premises.
- i) That it is incumbent to provide and to maintain at all times in good order and efficient action all such means and appliances as are necessary for rendering innocuous of all gas, vapour, fumes, dust or other impurities emitted during any trade process either from the articles operated upon or from the contents of any receptacle upon such premises or from any source whatever connected with the trade.
- j) That no part of the building in such premises shall be used at any time for purposes of human habitation.
- k) That the interior and exterior of every boiling pan and of every cask vat and all such appliances as are necessary for the trade and shall cause to be maintained at all times such storage tanks, boiling vessels and other appliances in a clean and sanitary condition and in good order and repair.
- l) Trade premises should be fitted with fly proof mesh and with glass.

- m) Carcasses should be hung to copper or stainless steel rods with hooks inside the trade premises. Meat/poultry etc shall under no circumstances be hung outside the shop premise.
- n) Different types of meat produce should be stored separately
- o) Slaughter should not be done in the Trade premises.
- p) Mutton and Beef should have the certification of Karnataka Animal Meat and Poultry Corporation.
- q) Besides these conditions imposed, I will also abide by all other regulations under all other Central and State laws connected in the upkeep of hygiene, safety and public health.
- r) That an inspection/complaints book shall always be available in the trade premises in which customers or Inspecting Officers may enter their remarks or note their complaints and such book shall be open to inspection by any Inspecting Officer of the Corporation.
- s) That it shall be competent for the Commissioner or any officer designated by him to remove or cause to be removed forthwith from such place any meat, fish, chicken etc, in their opinion, is stale, offensive or unfit for human consumption besides prosecuting the licensee for violating the bye-laws.

In accordance with these prescribed conditions I/we hereby state that I/we have, to the best of our knowledge and belief, have fulfilled the required conditions for the trade carried on by me/us before applying for this renewal of trade licence. If, upon inspection by the Commissioner or his delegated authority, it is found that I/we have not adhered to these conditions imposed, I/we are aware that the licence issued under the Automatic Trade Licence Approval Scheme, will be revoked. Further I /we HEREBY UNDERTAKE to indemnify/and keep harmless the Corporation from all proceedings in Court and before any other authorities including the competent authority under appropriate Central and State law in force, all express/losses/claims which the Corporation may incur or become liable to pay as a result or in consequence of the renewal of this trade licence.
